

### **BAS June 10th 2009 Meeting Minutes**

If you weren't at Chandler Field Saturday morning, June 20th, then you missed the 2nd annual BAS Spring Fling. Eight pilots flew and competed in Limbo, Oh Crap and Spot Landing to the amusement of many spectators.

Ken Jochim took 1st place in Spot Landing (electric) taking advantage of the no-wind conditions flying a very small and light weight bipe. Greg Hine took 2nd place with his red Aeroworks SU31. Boris Sergeev, Mike Morter and Al Coelho also competed. In Spot Landing (glow), Mike Broadstreet took 1st with his Ultra-Stick, Rudy Glick's and his Pawnee came in 2nd. Alex Bozanic came in 3rd.

In a death defying, grass skimming run, Boris Sergeev took 1st place in electric Limbo crossing under the tape at less than 3'. Greg Hine came in 2nd at 4', Mike Morter at 5' and Ken Jochim at 6'. Mike Broadstreet captured the glow Limbo at 5' as all other competitors DNF'ed trying to get under the tape.

Boris Sergeev might be able to win some serious money with the new higher limits at Black Hawk and Central City as he matched his first roll of the dice in the record time of 48 seconds after a quick flight of his electric 3D elight around the pattern. No one else was close with Mike Morter coming in second, Greg Hine 3rd, and Ken Jochim 4th.

Alex Bozanic, perhaps winning his first aviation competition as a very competent new pilot, took 1st honors in the Oh Crap (Las Vegas) glow competition expertly piloting his LT 40 around the pattern and matching his first roll of the dice at 1:06. Mike Broadstreet took 2nd place at 1:16. A grand time was had by all.

The club would like to thank Al Coelho, Boris Sergeev, Greg Hine and Rudy Furman for their excellent officiating of the event. We also thank Dean Chandler for the use of his t-stakes and PVC pipe for the limbo poles.

During the process of building your next masterpiece, it may become apparent that tail weight is required. Lead weight for fishing lines is available at most sporting goods stores in the form of round (about 1/8-inch diameter) strips, several inches long. The strip lead is easy to cut up and embedded in the model during construction. For example, strips of lead inserted under the triangle stock can be used to reinforce the fin or stabilizer on most model designs. It can also be inserted into wing tips to provide lateral balance
