#### Watch the Osprey Nest!

The ospreys have nested again this year on the dummy telephone pole erected by Boulder Parks northwest of the field. Please try to avoid flying or disturbing the ospreys, especially in August and September when the young chicks are learning to fly.

#### Be Careful When You Lock the Gate

We have been informed by the city that there have been a few times they could not access the field because the locks were not interlocked correctly when the gate was closed. Please, make sure you put the BAS (big) lock through the city (small) lock so that the city can open the chain with their lock alone.

## Flying Field Hours Clarification

The question of the flying field hours was recently brought up, partly because the old hours were established when we were in much closer proximity to our neighbors and electric powered models were almost unheard of. Although it seems logical that one could fly a quiet model outside of established flying hours without disturbing anyone, club members are advised not to do so.
