BAS MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 10, 2010 HOBBYTOWN USA LONGMONT, CO

Meeting called to order by **President Rich Anderson** at 7:00pm with 16 members and 2 guests present. Rich asked for a motion to accept last months meeting minutes as they appeared in the last newsletter. Motion to accept made by Dean Chandler with a second by Al Coelho. Motion voted and passed.

TREASURES REPORT-- In the absence of Treasurer Dean Ehn, Rich gave a detailed report of the clubs financial status.

1st VICE PRESIDENT REPORT--1st Vice President, Augie Bruno, stated we gained two new members Kirk Fehlberg and Erick Feierecon which brings our total membership to a to 74 members.

2nd VICE PRESIDENT REPORT-- 2nd Vice President David Goodnow reported we still have a problem with people standing on the runway instead of the flight stations while flying. David added the letters 2.4 to the S/S to help define the spread spectrum band on the frequency board.

OLD BUSINESS--Rich presented Kirk Fehlberg a certificate of Solo Flight ,Wings Pin and his club membership card. His Mother and Sister were present for the occasion, Also as part of the Mal Meador youth program Kirk received a new Hobbico Super Star model aircraft and a Futaba radio. Club members expressed their approval with a round of applause. Rich reported no new update on boat inspection program. Ken Jochim reported on the WINGS OVER THE ROCKIES event and asked members to let him know if they are bringing a model for display. Augie will email members to let Ken know if they are bringing a model. Rich informed us the club has city approval to add gravel to the parking lot and to repair the blacktop in the pit and taxi-way. A discussion was held on buying gravel for the parking and shelter area. Ken Miller a made motion to buy two loads of gravel. More discussion followed about shortage of funds to do both the gravel and the blacktop. Ken withdrew his motion to buy gravel until a later date. Last months motion on paving pits and taxi-way will stand as is.

Jerry Depoorter asked the club to look into the guest policy for use of the boat for float flying. Motion to adjourn by Al Coelho with a second by Ken Jochim. Motion voted and passed.
