Parts Painting, Italian Style

Ever wonder how you're going to paint that cowling or those wheels pants for your latest project when you don't have a professional paint spray booth in your custom 4,000 square foot workshop? Here's a tip that will give you great results!

I've used 'rattle cans' and painted outside when the conditions were right, wearing a glove and wrapping my arm in Saran wrap so I could hold the part while painting. But never again! I've discovered a new paint stand that beats that hands-down.

An inverted wire Tomato stand. This versatile device has a wide, stable base, brings the work up to waist level and allows hand free painting from almost any angle. The upright prongs can be bent into virtually any configuration and you'll find ways to adequately support almost any airplane part. Best of all you can reuse the stand next summer to support your latest crop of beefsteaks!

A word of caution. Pick a nice, warm wind-free day and work downwind from your house!
