LETTER OF AGREEMENT FOR OPERATING UNMANNED AERIAL SYSTEMS

This LETTER OF AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement"), effective this 15th day of January, 2019, by and between the BOULDER MUNICIPAL AIRPORT (hereinafter referred to as the "Airport") and BOULDER AEROMODELING SOCIETY, whose address is 8083 Meadow Lake Road. Niwot, Colorado, 80503 (hereinafter referred to as the "Operator").

Recitals

WHEREAS, the Airport is located in the northeast portion of the City of Boulder with a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) designated airport reference point of LAT 40° 02.36'N and LON 105° 13.57'W; and

WHEREAS, Operator desires to operate unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) at a permanent location within five statute miles of the Airport, which requires a letter of agreement in accordance with the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012, Section 336.

Covenants and Conditions

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals, promises, covenants, and conditions set forth herein, and other good and valuable considerations herein receipted for, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Operator shall comply with all provisions stated within the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012 and other applicable FAA regulations.
 - A. Operator shall only operate UASs for hobby or recreational use. No commercial activity shall be permitted without an additional FAA waiver for Section 333 and a Letter of Agreement with the Boulder Municipal Airport, or are complying with Part 107 certification requirements from the FAA.
 - B. UAS Operations shall take place during daylight hours only; must remain below 400 feet above ground level (AGL), and yield to manned aircraft at all times.
 - C. Operator shall comply with the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) Safety Code.
- 2. UAS operations shall take place within 1 mile of the Boulder Model Airport located on North 55th Street in the city of Boulder, with a GPS reference point of 40° 05.142'N and 105 13.985'W. Operations outside of this coordinated area must be pre-approved by the Airport at least one business day in advance.

- 5. This Agreement does not exempt the Operator from complying with other FAA airspace restrictions or AMA operating procedures.
- 6. This Agreement represents the entire and only agreement between the parties regarding UAS operations and may be cancelled at any time by the Airport upon notice. Any and all prior Agreements between the parties are superseded and extinguished by this Agreement.
